3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Irritant - risk of serious damage to eyes.

Irritant - irritating to skin.

Harmful to aquatic organisms, may cause long-term adverse effects in the aquatic environment..

Contains 2,4-dimethylcyclohex-3-ene-1-carbaldehyde, 2-(4-tert-butylbenzyl)propionaldehyde, alpha-hexylcinnamaldehyde. May produce an allergic reaction.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES

Eyes : Rinse immediately with plenty of water, holding the eyelids open and seek medical advice.

Inhalation : Remove from source of exposure. Seek medical advice if effects persist.

Skin : Wash thoroughly with soap and water.

Ingestion : Remove product from mouth, give the casualty a small quantity of water to drink and seek medical advice. Do not induce vomiting.

5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

NON FLAMMABLE - In the event of a fire due to other causes the product is compatible with water, foam, carbon dioxide and dry powder extinguishers. May evolve toxic fumes if involved in a fire. Firefighters should wear self contained breathing apparatus.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Wear suitable gloves and eye/face protection. Hose away with plenty of water diluting to at least 2.5% w/v (25 g/litre) unless this would contaminate a water course or vegetation, in which case either collect, dilute as earlier and pour down wastewater drain (foul sewer) or absorb onto dry sand or similar material and dispose of safely as commercial waste.

7. HANDLING & STORAGE

Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wear suitable eye/face protection. Rinse and dry hands after use, for prolonged contact protection of the hands may be necessary. Do not mix with any other chemicals other than as advised by your JohnsonDiversey representative.

Store upright in original closed containers in a cool place.
